Trailer test change welcome but road safety a priority From 16 December 2021, there will be an automatic ability for those with a full car driving licence to tow a trailer with a car without an additional test. The move is part of Government efforts to free up the reported backlog in driving tests. This will only apply where the trailer is up to a Maximum Authorised Mass (MAM) of 3,500kg. Licences will be updated to reflect this change. **In the interests of road safety, as well as to help comply with Health and Safety legislation, members are being encouraged to ensure that all staff who may have cause to tow a trailer with a car undertake training.**

Many courses can be run at short notice but can incur greater costs if they are not full.

Training during Covid 19—course costs may be slightly higher due to fewer trainees per course or larger venues being used. You can request training for your business only. LFTs should be taken before attending any training course.

The instructor will make an assessment on the day when applying the Covid Risk Assessment. A copy of this is sent out in advance of training and can be requested from the office.
